

33 1/2 Years

Once we have decided to follow Jesus, how should we live? The life of Christ, or 33 1/2 years is a pattern by which we should live our lives every day. When we get up in the morning, the first thing we need to do is to be born again. When we are born again, God gives us three gifts. Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh. In the Bible Gold represents faith, Frankincense represents prayer and Myrrh represents being dead to sin and self. When we get up in the morning, God wants us to know that Herod will try to get to us before we mature in our Christian walk. We need to be careful. But God has promised to take care of us if we trust Him.

After we have gotten past Herod in the morning, we think of what Christ was like as a child because we can't live as the man Jesus Christ if we haven't lived first as He did as a child. At the age of 12, Jesus discovered what His mission was. Every morning before we head out the door, we should know what our mission is. God will speak to us and let us know, and if our ears are open we will hear it. Then from the age of 12, Christ began to work in His father's shop as a carpenter. We ought to pray and ask God that as we go through our day to work as diligently at school or in our job as Jesus worked as a carpenter.

Then at age 30, the Bible says that Jesus was baptised. Every morning should be asking God to baptise us with the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was baptised, a voice could be heard saying 'This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased.' Imagine that being said of you and I on a daily basis. 'This is my beloved son or daughter in whom I am well pleased.' Then God will send a heavenly dove on your shoulder to walk with you throughout the day. We all need this heavenly dove.

But then what happens next? Christ is led into the wilderness and is tempted three times. And throughout the day Satan will also tempt us. He will tempt us to turn stone into bread or to take part in what is unlawful for us and make it seem right. He will tempt us to throw ourselves down to sin because God will forgive us later. He will tempt us to bow down to something we know is wrong and have us think that he'll give us everything we want. But we can overcome all these temptations. Jesus overcame with the power of the spirit. And if we spent time in prayer in the morning, we too can overcome in the power of the spirit.

Then as we go about our day, it is all about turning water into wine which was Christ's first miracle. This includes doing things which may seem mundane and small like going out and saying 'hello' to someone, helping someone or giving them an encouraging word. All this is considered as turning water into wine or making the Gospel sweet for those who partake of it. That is what God has called us to do.

Then throughout the day, we know that at some point we need to come aside to rest awhile. So we take a break and go talk with Jesus again, after which we go back into the work field.

Then evening comes and it is time for the last supper or the evening meal. It is time to gather the family around as Jesus gathered His disciples around. It is time to love one another and wash each other's feet and ask each other if we have done anything to offend the other. We need to make sure that everything is good with everybody, because we don't want any Judases in the family that could eventually betray Jesus.

Then after we've said goodnight to everyone, it is time for us to go alone to the garden to pray because we know that we'll need everything in our power to stand up to the trials and conflicts that we'll have in the next day. And then we get up from our knees and are ready to be nailed to the cross.

Between the time that we get up from our knees and the time we go to bed, the devil is going to be trying to get us down from the cross. The devil is going to do everything in his power to make sure that we do not go to sleep without first honouring him. So, we get up from our evening prayer and then the phone rings, and it's the kind of phone call that we wished we didn't get - it is

the devil saying 'Come down from that cross.' And by the grace of God, we can answer and say 'I will not come down from this cross. Love is going to hold me up here.'

Then as we lay down in bed and our eyes begin to close, what are we thinking about? We are thinking about Jesus on the cross. As Jesus' eyes began to close, what did He pray? And what do we pray? "Into thy hands I commend my spirit." Do you know that the devil can't penetrate the life of Christ? If we live the life of Christ, there's no way that the devil can get in it because Christ lived it for us. And all we've got to do is walk in it.

But it doesn't there. The Bible tells us that Herod had Roman soldiers guarding Christ's tomb. The devil also has soldiers around our bed to keep us sleeping so that we don't get up to have enough time to pray. But God sent an angel who caused an earthquake and said 'Son, thy Father calls.' And so, our heavenly Father will call us every morning too. Then after getting up and if we haven't prayed yet, we can say 'Touch me not, for I have not ascended to my Father in prayer.'

When we understand the life and power of Christ, we can know that Christ can give us the strength we need to get through every day. We can live 33 1/2 years in a day, every day.

Recipes



Prosperity Golden Bag

Ingredients:

(A)

Needle Mushroom 150g

Mushroom 100 g

Carrot 70 g

Broccoli 150 g

Celery 100 g

(B)

Tofu Sheet 2 pieces

(C) (Seasoning)

Soy sauce 2 tbsp

Sesame oil 2 tsp

Rock salt 1 teaspoon

(D)

Vegetarian Oyster Sauce 2 tbsp

Water 1/2 cup

Corn flour 2 tbsp

Dressing: (E) Lime Juice, Sweet Orange Juice, Pineapple juice

Side Dish: Cucumber, Tomato, Pineapple, Carrot Slices

Method:

- 1. Cook the mushrooms in (A) first.
- 2. Wash the (A) material and cut into pieces. Then add into the wok and add (C) seasoning. Stir fry and serve on a plate.
- 3. (B) Cut tofu sheet and wrapped the stir fry content into it and tied neatly.
- 4. Put a little oil in the pan and fry the tofu bag until turn golden brown. Add the (E) and (D) dressing onto it. Wait until it's dry before serving.



Purple Fantasy

Ingredients:

Purple Cabbage 3 (medium)

Sesame Seeds 3 tbsp

Coconut Powder 3 tbsp

Side Dish Lettuce

Method:

- 1. Wash the 3 red cabbage heads and slice into strings.
- 2. Wash the lettuce and put them on the plater.
- 3. Then place the red cabbage sliced strings on the lettuce.
- 4. Add sesame seeds, coconut powder and nuts on top of it.


